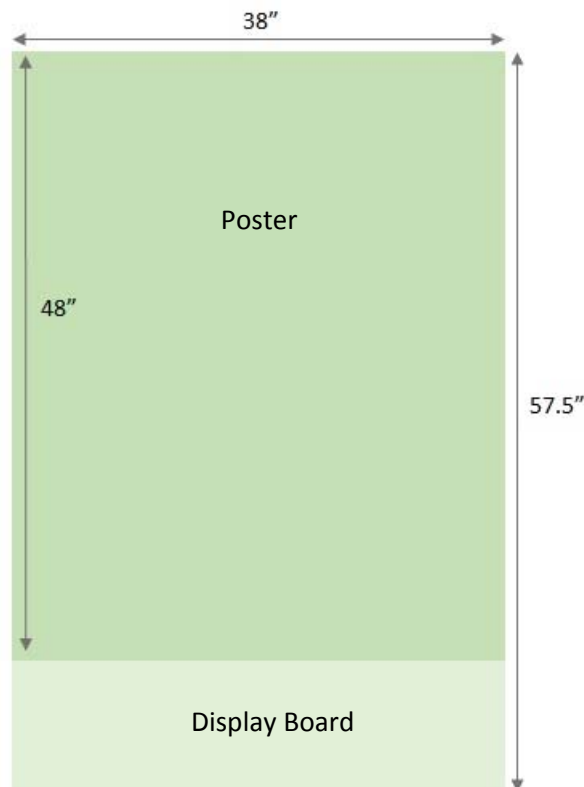

## Poster Presentation Guidelines

### A) POSTER DISPLAY

- Size of the display board is 38 inches (96.5 cm) in width x 57.5 inches (146 cm) in height.
- **For best viewing, the suggested poster size is 38 inches (96.5 cm) in width x 48 inches (122 cm) in height as below:**



- Presenters should be available during the assigned session to discuss their posters with other participants.
- Posters must be written in English. Lettering should be at least 10 mm in height for good visibility.
- Each poster must have a top banner indicating the title of the abstract and the name(s) of the author(s).
- Do not fold poster: roll it up and keep it in a cardboard container.
- Do not mail poster to the conference organiser in advance.

- Presenters are required to put up and dismantle their posters on/from the allocated display boards. The organiser will not take responsibility for any loss or damage of the display materials during the event.
- Push pins for mounting posters will be available at the poster display areas.
- Presenters are responsible for preparing all the necessary materials for the display of their posters.
- Display boards are located at G/F and 2/F, Yasumoto International Academic Park (YIA), The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK).

## **B) DISPLAY SCHEDULE**

- Each poster will be displayed for either a half day on 2 March 2016, or one day on 3 or 4 March 2016.
- Presenters should put up their posters before 11:30 on 2 March 2016 and 08:30 on 3-4 March 2016.
- Locations of poster display boards:
  - Board No. 1-12: G/F, YIA, CUHK
  - Board No. 13-57: 2/F, YIA, CUHKPlease go to the Registration Counter for enquiries about poster displaying locations.
- Presenters should dismantle their posters by 18:30 on 2 March 2016 and 17:30 on 3-4 March 2016. Any poster not being dismantled after the scheduled time will be discarded.
