#### Cochrane Hong Kong > Updates



Since October, Cochrane Hong Kong has published 36 translated Cochrane Review abstracts or plain language summaries in simplified Chinese (n=33) and traditional Chinese (n=3).

All abstracts and plain language summaries in simplified Chinese are now available on the <u>Cochrane China</u> website and the <u>Cochrane official website</u>, while the plain language summaries in traditional Chinese in collaboration with Cochrane Taiwan are now available on the <u>Cochrane Hong Kong</u> website.

As a co-organiser, Cochrane Hong Kong actively promoted the Cochrane Evidence Translation and Dissemination Competition in the international context.
