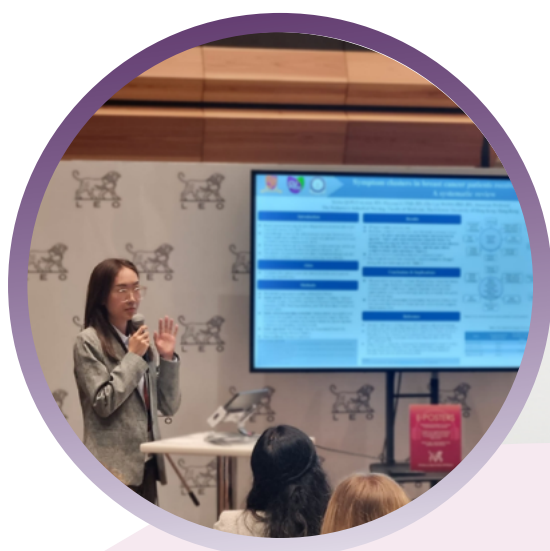

Connecting to Prestigious Fellowships Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS)

The Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme was established by the Hong Kong Research Grants Council (RGC) in 2009 with an aim to attract the best and brightest students from all over the world to pursue their PhD studies in Hong Kong. The Scheme provides a monthly stipend and annual conference travel allowance to each awardee for a maximum period of three years. Applicants applying for admission to a full-time PhD programme through the HKPFS



are required to comply with the admission requirements of the CUHK Graduate School, and should demonstrate outstanding qualities of academic performance, research abilities/ potentials, communication and interpersonal skills, and leadership abilities. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

General Admission Requirements:

- A master's degree from a recognised university; or
- Graduated from a recognised university with a bachelor's degree, normally achieving an average grade of not lower than "B" in undergraduate courses; or
- Graduated from an honours programme of a recognised university with a bachelor's degree, normally with honours not lower than Second Class; or
- Completed a course of study in a tertiary educational institution and obtained professional or similar qualifications equivalent to an honours degree.

English Language Requirements:

Applicants are required to fulfil the English Language requirements of Graduate School prior to admissions. Please refer to the website of the CUHK Graduate School for details: <https://www.gs.cuhk.edu.hk/admissions/admissions/requirements>

Programme-specific Requirements:

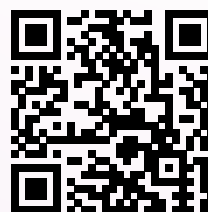
MPhil: Submit a written statement of research interest with a brief outline of research proposal (600 words in English).

PhD: Submit an outline research proposal with justification for the chosen area of research (1,000 words in English).
